	Supporting the Well-Being of our SCDSB students, staff and families <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Review of the team members/supports</li> <li>- Achieving Excellence document</li> <li>- Well-being is one quarter (one of four pillars) of Board strategic priorities</li> <li>- Leading Mentally Healthy Schools – implementation of supports across the board (with support from School Mental Health ASIST)</li> <li>- 3 tiers of support – bottom of pyramid are school supports – ‘good for all’</li> <li>- ‘Noticing’ signs of a struggle is important bridge between bottom and middle tiers (i.e. referring to SW)</li> <li>- Top pillar is smallest portion of our school system; level of support is outside of school</li> <li>- Scdsb public website has links to community mental health supports</li> <li>- Capacity Building – many opportunities for staff to learn and become trained</li> <li>- Self-Reg for Parents is an available framework/workshop (self-reg.ca); Stuart Shanker</li> <li>- Misbehavior vs. stress behavior is self-reg root; 5 steps – i.reframe behavior, ii.recognize stressors, iii.reduce the stress, iv.reflect (enhance stress awareness), v.respond (promote restoration)</li> <li>- March 28 Seasons Centre for Grieving Children Education Day (Susan Hopkins from The Mehrit Centre) – focus on co-regulation; free event in the evening for parents at Liberty North on Caplan off Mapleview</li> <li>- Eastview was one of 6 schools involved in the Mindfulness Without Borders pilot last year</li> <li>- 2 outdoor education conferences this year</li> <li>-</li> <li>-</li> </ul>
